

As a group, the Finance Committee meets in three parts to provide oversight and direction for the church's finances. Each member also serves on subcommittees, with additional meetings to provide specific directions on budgeting, audit review, capital needs, and membership.

Hayes Barton operates on a calendar-year budget, and we typically finalize our budget by the end of the first quarter. This year, we finished the budget in January and had it approved by the Church Council on January 21, 2026.
