
### Rise Against Hunger Meal Packaging Event

We now offer a Sunday shuttle service in partnership with White Memorial Presbyterian Church. The shuttle will run to and from the parking lot located at


1309 Annapolis Drive Raleigh, NC 27608

Hayes Barton United Methodist Church was established on December 6, 1936. The Reverend Leon Russell was our first pastor. One hundred-seven charter members originally assembled in the old Hayes Barton School (now Underwood Elementary). In December of 1937, a building site for the new church was purchased at the corner of Fairview Road and Stone Street for \$3,500. Formal opening of the new church building occurred on Sunday, September 10, 1939. In the years until ground was broken for our current sanctuary, Hayes Barton was affectionately known as the "Church in the Pines."
