



Please remember:

- Our pastors and staff will never ask you for money, gift cards, or personal information by email or text.
- Always check the sender's email address carefully. Legitimate messages will come from an @hbumc.org address.
- If you receive a suspicious message, **do not respond**—call the church office to verify. If the email is not valid, **delete** it and report it as junk to your email provider.


